HOLLYWOOD & Wine

Francis Ford Coppola

Francis Ford Coppola has been making movies for more than 30 years, and wines at his Niebaum-Coppola Estate Winery in the Napa Valley for almost 20. In February 1995 he purchased the massive stone Inglenook Chateau and its adjacent vineyards. This purchase reunited the original Napa Valley estate founded in 1879 by Gustave Niebaum and preserves his legacy for future generations.

Arizona Stronghold

Maynard Keenan, lead singer for Tool, partnered with Eric Glomski to launch Arizona Stronghold Vineyards, and the two became movie makers with their documentary "Blood Into Wine." Arizona Stronghold Vineyards was formed to put Arizona on the fine wine map. While small bastions of artistry have made a few waves with wine aficionados, Arizona still remains a vinous backwater in the minds of the wine world. Despite this, there is a distinct hunger in Arizona for indigenous wines. The potential to make great wine has always existed in the Southwest, yet the talent and willingness to invest here had yet to fully blossom until recently. Enjoy a taste of Arizona from the bottle and open your mind to the potential of the stunning landscape.

Dan Aykroyd

Dan Aykroyd's affinity for travel has taken him around the globe. Whether visiting Asia, Europe, Africa, Australia or the Americas, Dan makes it a point to visit local wineries, talk to local winemakers and sample their wines. Inspired by the culture, passion and dedication for producing great wines, Dan has teamed up with some of his favorite winemakers to create a series of regionally inspired and modestly priced wines that represent the best of each territory.

Charles Smith

Owner-winemaker Charles Smith with his big hair, kick-ass attitude and bold packaging arrived in the Walla Walla Valley following eleven years in Scandinavia managing

rock bands. Originally hailing from northern California, he has been involved with wine personally and professionally his entire life.

Fess Parker Winery

When Fess Parker was cast in the role of Davy Crockett in the mid-1950's, it caused an international sensation and changed his life forever. So too did the purchase of 714 acres in the Santa Ynez Valley change the course of the Parker family's history. After his acting career, Parker devoted much of his time to operating his Fess Parker Family Winery and Vineyards in Los Olivos, California. The winery is owned and operated by Parker's family, and has produced several different types of award-winning wines.

Bruce Cohn

Bruce Cohn was manager for one of rock 'n' roll's perennially favorite American bands, The Doobie Brothers. Founded in 1984 in the heart of Sonoma Valley, B.R. Cohn Winery is renowned for producing balanced, elegant wines that maintain a standard of excellence from year to year. Cohn purchased the property in 1974 and named it Olive Hill Vineyards, after the rare 140-year-old Picholine olive trees imported from France in the mid 1800s, that surround the property.

Hollywood & Vine Cellars

When you hear the words "Hollywood and Vine," the famous intersection in Los Angeles might come to mind, but for us, the name represents the partnership between friends and a mutual love of wine. Actor turned director and screenwriter, Doug Barr, relocated to the Napa Valley from Hollywood, in the early 1990's. Inspired to try his hand at the wine business, Doug called his longtime pal, Bruce Orosz, and together, they created Hollywood and Vine Cellars. Recruiting one of the most talented winemakers in the valley, Celia Welch, H & V released its first vintage in 1998 to glowing reviews.
